Crucial Education Bills from the 2016 General Assembly Session

HB 524 – Preserves confidentiality of teacher performance data
Bill passed.

SB 564 – Preserves confidentiality of teacher licensure and re-licensure applications
Bill passed.

SB 364 – Statewide health insurance option for school boards and local governments
Bill passed.

HB 3 – Constitutional Amendment to give the Virginia Board of Education charter granting authority
Amendment failed.

HB 8 – Stand-alone statewide virtual school
Bill passed, vetoed by governor.

HB 389 – Parental choice savings accounts (vouchers)
Bill passed, vetoed by governor.
