2018 LEGISLATIVE

Report Card

Crucial Education Bills from the 2018 General Assembly Session

House Bill 1044 (Torian) requires each local school division to establish policies and practices to maintain bully-free work environments. *Full vote of the House; passed Senate 39-1.*

House Bill 1125 (Landes) changed the teacher licensure process and extends licenses to 10 years. *Full vote of the House where the bill passed 100-0. Identical Senate Bill 349 (Peake) passed 40-0.*

Medicaid Expansion was a vote on the House of Delegate's budget that expanded Medicaid in Virginia. *Full vote of the House where Medicaid expansion passed.*

House Bill 1119 (VanValkenburg) was a VEA-initiated bill requiring a statewide school climate survey. It was killed by the Appropriations Committee. *This score is of the House Education Committee, where it passed 21-1. Identical Senate Bill 456 (McClellan) passes 39-0 but died in House Appropriations.*

House Bill 1286 (LaRock) would have created a statewide voucher program. *The score is of the House Education Subcommittee, where the bill died 4-4.*

House Bill 1501 (Hurst) was a VEA-initiated bill eliminating veto authority over all recommendations by a small group of legislators on the SOL Innovation Committee. *The score is of the House Rules Committee, where the bill died 11-6.*

Senate Bill 261 (Seutterlein) would have allowed school divisions to use state funding for librarians to hire non-librarians. *Passed Senate 21-17 before being killed in House Education.*

Expand Medicaid was a vote to adopt an amendment to the Senate budget during the regular session. *The amendment died 21-19.*

Senate Bill 516 (Obenshain) would have allowed the State Board of Education to approve and open charter schools in Virginia. *The bill died in Senate Finance 16-0.*
