PROPOSED VEA GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

I. Promote the importance of quality public education for children of the Commonwealth and the contributions of public education employees in the state of Virginia.

- A. Implement effective programs designed to enhance the image of public education for members and the community at-large.
- B. Develop and maintain effective coalitions with groups and individuals for the purpose of promoting public education.
- C. Work to achieve full funding of public education.

II. Secure adequate compensation, benefits, and employment rights for public education employees in Virginia.

- A. Provide resources to assist local affiliates in achieving a professional level of compensation, comprehensive employee benefits, and adequate working conditions.
- B. Institute at the state and local levels activities designed to secure fair collective bargaining legislation for educational employees.
- C. Institute at the state and local levels activities designed to protect and enhance members' legal rights.
- D. Institute at the state and local levels activities designed to protect human and civil rights.
- E. Institute at the state and local levels activities designed to achieve a grievance procedure with binding arbitration.

III. Advocate professional issues on behalf of public education employees and children in Virginia.

- A. Promote activities designed to secure the enactment of professional standards legislation.
- B. Ensure employee involvement in decision-making at all levels.

IV. Provide programs and services responsive to the needs of local affiliates and members of the VEA.

- A. Implement a system of staff assistance to enhance the delivery of services to Association members.
- B. Provide programs and resources designed to address member professional development interests and concerns.
- C. Develop and implement special benefit programs for members of the Association.

V. Promote organizational strength and cohesion.

- A. Implement programs designed to assist in the development of local affiliate leaders.
- B. Provide assistance to local affiliates' membership recruitment organizing efforts.
- C. Facilitate an effective system of two-way communications between the state association and its local affiliates.
