Virginia Education Association Education Support Professional of the Year Award

Calling all Local Affiliates to nominate an ESP member who is actively engaged in their profession, Association and community.

Purpose: The VEA Education Support Professional of the Year Award recognizes the

contributions that Education Support Professionals make toward their schools, communities and professions. The award is presented to a member of the VEA who demonstrates outstanding accomplishments and reflects the contributions of ESP to public

education.

Award: Each year, one nominee receives the **VEA ESP of the Year Award**. The recipient would

receive funding, to include travel and lodging, to attend the National ESP Conference. The winner will be recognized at the VEA Delegate Assembly. The winner will also

receive a monetary gift of \$250.

Deadline: All nominations must be received at VEA no later than 4:30 pm on

January 11, 2021.

Nomination and Selection Procedure

Nominations: Each local may submit **only one nominee through an ESP award program**. A local

ESP award program is defined as one developed by the local that solicits nominations and

selects one award recipient.

Eligibility: All Education Support Professional members of a local affiliate who have been VEA

members for at least **three years** as of January 11th of the award year are eligible.

Nominees must be an "active" member at the time of selection. Individuals must be

nominated by their local through an ESP award program.

Selection: All nominations must comply with the nomination guidelines. The ESP Committee will

review all nominations to ensure that eligibility and submission requirements are met. The ESP Committee will forward its recommendation to the VEA President/Board of Directors for presentation at the Virginia Education Association Delegate Assembly.

Notification: The VEA Education Support Professional Award will be presented at the 2021 VEA

Delegate Assembly.

Criteria: Nominations are judged according to the following five criteria: **Professional Practice**;

Member Advocacy and Association Involvement; Community Engagement; Personal Achievement; and Enhancement of ESP Image. Based on the information, the ESP Committee members will rate nominees on a scale of 1 to 5 for each criterion, where '1' represents minimal evidence of the criterion, and '5' represents very strong evidence of

the criterion.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- 1. The nomination package **must** be typed. **Handwritten** documents will **NOT** be accepted.
- 2. Do **NOT** include covers, photos of the nominee, articles or news clippings about the nominee, any other materials not specified in these guidelines.
- 3. Include **ONLY** the materials requested in these guidelines.
- 4. The complete nomination package must be emailed as a <u>Microsoft Word</u> document to <u>arobinson@veanea.org</u>. Hard copies and faxed copies will not be accepted.
- 5. The complete nomination package must be received at VEA via email no later than 4:30 pm on January 11, 2021.

Nominations that do not conform to deadlines and format specifications will be disqualified.

All nomination applications will be saved in file at VEA for one (1) year.

*The ESP Committee and staff liaison will assist the VEA ESP of the Year award winner to apply to the NEA ESP of the Year nomination.

VEA ESP of the Year Award Nomination and Formatting Guidelines

Nomination packet must include all of the materials listed below.

(Lim	Sheet it 1-page maximum, 12-point font, Must use provided form. Handwritten data sheets will not be pted.)			
Local Affiliate Acknowledgement Form (Limit 1-page maximum, 12-point font, Must use provided form. Must be signed by the local president. Handwritten forms will not be accepted.)				
Nominee Statement (Limit 5-page maximum, 12-point font, double-spaced, one-inch margins on all sides) Each criterion must be clearly labeled with the corresponding criterion heading to aid the Selection Committee with their review. Must give specific examples of achievement in each of the five criterion area and must provide examples of how the nominee goes above and beyond the roles and responsibilities of his/her job description.				
*	Professional Practice: Worksite responsibilities and professional achievements the nominee has made in his/her field; must include at least one example of how the nominee has directly impacted student success in his/her school or worksite.			
*	Member Advocacy and Association Involvement: Evidence of leadership, creativity and innovation in advocating for members, for the profession and for public education; evidence of involvement in NEA or its affiliates and how that involvement contributes to professional success; evidence that the nominee engages in member recruitment activities and encourages fellow members to be more active.			
*	Community Engagement: Details on how the nominee is involved in promoting public education within the community through charitable projects and activities and examples of how that involvement has benefited students, families and other members.			
*	Personal Achievement: A description of the nominee's personal and/or professional goals; what they have done or are doing to meet these goals; how his/her growth and goals benefit students, members and/or families or the larger community; and advice they would give to a colleague entering the profession.			
*	Enhancement of ESP Image: Details of how the nominee's activities have enhanced the image of Education Support Professionals at the worksite, in the Association and in the community.			
space Lette of the (i.e., achie	ers of Recommendation st include three letters (no more or no less than 3), Limit 2-page maximum for each letter, double- ed, 12-point font, one-inch margins on all sides, Handwritten letters will not be accepted.) ers of recommendation <u>must</u> answer the question, "Why does this nominee deserve the 2021 VEA ESP e Year Award?" through specific examples of accomplishments related to the Nominee Statement criteria professional practice; member advocacy and association involvement; community engagement; personal evement; and enhancement of ESP image). The letters <u>must</u> also provide examples of how the nominee goes e and beyond the roles and responsibilities of his/her job description.			

The letters should be from those who know the nominee well. One letter must come from someone at the nominee's worksite, one must be from an individual at the nominee's local (such as elected leaders, members or staff) and one must be from an individual in the nominee's community (such as current or former students, parents of students, community members, etc.). Letters must note how long the writer has known the nominee and in what capacity the writer can comment on the nominee's accomplishments.
